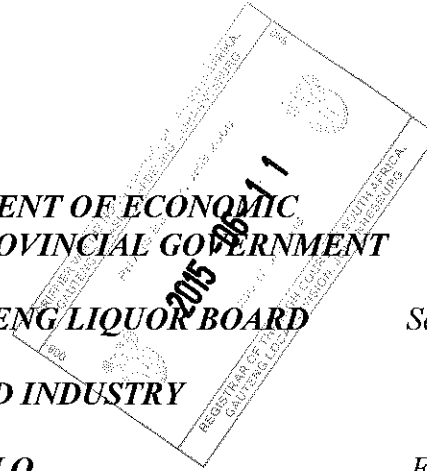

HAVING read the documents filed of record and having considered the matter:-

BY AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE PARTIES, IT IS ORDERED THAT:-

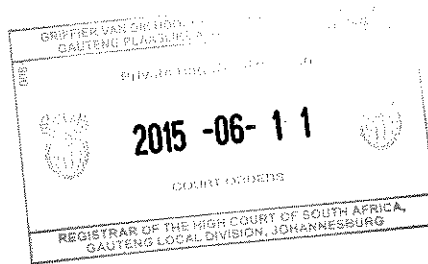
- 1 *In accordance with the Notice on the Status of Shebeen Licence Applications, made under the Gauteng Liquor Regulations on Shebeen Licences ("the Regulations") and published in the Provincial Government Gazette, 288 ("the Notice"), no shebeen licences shall be processed or granted pending the final determination of this matter.*
- 2 *As recorded in the Notice, a holder of a shebeen permit who has applied for a shebeen licence in terms of the Regulations shall be entitled to continue trading under that shebeen permit pending the final determination of this matter.*
- 3 *The first and second respondents shall within ten (10) days of the date of this order, provide to the applicants the following information in written form –*
 - 3.1 *the identity and the physical address of all those persons whom or which are holders of valid shebeen permits under the Gauteng Liquor Act, 2 of 2003, and have made application on the basis of such shebeen permits for shebeen licenses under the Regulations; and*
 - 3.2 *where the persons referred in paragraph 3.1 above are represented by an association, society or something of that nature, the name and address of such association or society, in each case indicating which persons referred to in paragraph 3.1 are so represented.*



- 4 *The applicants are ordered to effect service of this application on all the persons referred to in paragraph 3 above within thirty (30) days of receipt of the information sought in paragraph 3 above.*

- 5 *In the alternative to paragraph 4 above, if, in light of the information disclosed to the applicants under paragraph 3 above, it should appear that service in the ordinary course is not practicable, the applicants shall within thirty (30) days of receiving the information sought in paragraph 3 above, launch an application for an order by which it might serve this application upon the persons mentioned in paragraph 3 above by way of substituted service.*

- 6 *The costs of this application are reserved.*
