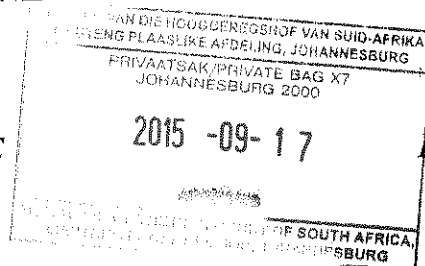

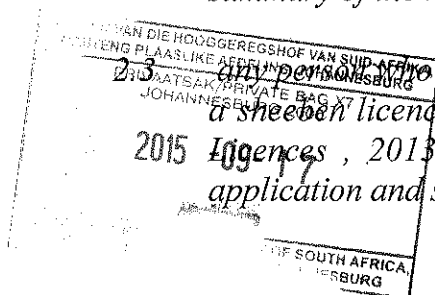

HAVING read the documents filed of record and having considered the matter:-

IT IS ORDERED THAT:-

1. *The Applicants are granted leave to serve the main application under the above case number ("the main application") of the persons listed in annexure "AK3" ("the shebeen licence Applicants") within 90 days from the date on which such this order was made by way of publication in both the Daily Sun and the Sunday Times newspapers and also by posting within 30 days from the date on which this order was made a copy of the publication, endorsed by the Registrar, on the main notice in this Honourable Court.*
2. *The publication in paragraph 1 shall be in the form of the notice in annexure "B" and which contains the following in English, Zulu and Sotho:*
 - 2.1 *the case number and names of the current parties to the main application;*
 - 2.2 *the date when the main application was launched and a brief summary of the relief sought in the notice of motion in it;*



any person who has applied for a sheeben permit to be converted into a sheeben licence under the Gauteng Liquor Regulations on Sheeben Licences, 2013 may be affected by the relief sought in the main application and should consider whether to oppose it;

- 2.4 *a link to the First Applicant's website, www.yeoville.org.za , and that a complete electronic copy of the papers filed of record to date in the main application shall be available on it for download by any visitor to the website;*
- 2.5 *the Applicant's attorneys of record's physical address at 155, Fifth Street, Sandton, Johannesburg, and that a hard copy of the main application shall be available there for inspection and copying by any sheeben licence Applicant (at his or her own expenses) from the date of publication; and*
- 2.6 *any sheeben licence Applicant who wished to oppose the main application should file under Uniform Rule of Court 6(5) a notice of intention to oppose in the main application within fifteen days from the date of publication.*
3. *Any sheeben licence Applicant who seeks to oppose the main application shall within fifteen days of the date of publication of either of the two notices as ordered in paragraphs 1 and 2 deliver his or her notice of intention to oppose, if any, and the Uniform Rules of Court shall apply to the filing of further papers in the main application.*
4. *The Applicants shall file an original tear sheet of both publications as ordered in paragraphs 1 and 2 within 15 days after publication.*
